ADMISSION REGULATIONS FOR UG PROGRAMMES

Admission will be made to various courses as per Autonomous College Regulations. Candidates who have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination are eligible to seek admission. Last date fixed for the issue and submission of the application forms will be announced on the college notice board. Applications which are incomplete and without necessary documents will be rejected. List of selected candidates for admission will be announced. The candidates can apply through online for Aided Courses.

- 1. Students should get themselves admitted before the last date failing which they lose their right of admission.
- 2. Admissions are given only for one academic year. The college authorities have the right to deny admission for the succeeding year in case of misbehaviour.
- 3. At the time of admission, students should submit all necessary original documents and pay the first instalment fee. Fees once paid will not be refunded for any reason.
- 4. The students should sign the admission register in person.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Certificates to be produced at the time of admission

- Marks Card (Original + 2 Photo copies)
- Transfer Certificate (Original + 2 Photo copies)
- Conduct Certificate (Original + 2 Photo copies)
- Income declaration form duly signed by the Tahsildar for students whose parents' annual income is below Rs. 1,00,000/- (Original + 3 Photo copies) for OBC and Rs. 2,50,000 for SC
- Students of other universities and foreign countries have to submit to the college the Eligibility Certificate obtained from University of Mysore.

ATTENDANCE

- 1. Each semester shall be taken as a unit for the purpose of calculating attendance and a student shall be considered to have put in the required attendance for the Semester, if he/she has attended not less than 75% of the number of working hours/periods in each paper/subject in each semester.
- 2. The candidate who fails to satisfy the requirement of attendance in a semester will not be allowed to appear for the examination.
- 3. The provisions for condonation of shortage of attendance are subject to the directions of University / State Government / UGC issued from time to time.

LIBRARY RULES

- 1. Borrower's card will be issued to every student at the beginning of the year. It is not transferable. It should be surrendered at the end of the year.
- 2. Admission to the library is only on the production of Identity Card.
- 3. Books will be issued as per the time-table framed for this purpose.
- 4. Books returned late will be liable for fine.
- 5. Duplicate Identity Card will be issued on payment of prescribed fee after following the set procedure.
- 6. Duplicate Borrower's Card will be issued on payment of prescribed fee.
- 7. Books should be returned in good condition, failing which fine may be levied.
- 8. Books meant for Reference and Encyclopedia are not allowed to be taken out.
- 9. A student can keep the books for not more than two weeks. He/She can, however, return the books earlier.
- 10. Borrower's cards are to be surrendered at the time of borrowing books and claimed back when the books are returned.
- 11. Students have to maintain discipline and complete silence both in the Library as well as in the Reference Section.
- 12. Newspapers and periodicals are to be returned in good condition, failing which fine will be levied.

2. MSc (Chemistry)

BSc with Chemistry as one of the Major / Optional subjects with minimum aggregate marks (excluding languages) of 45% for GM and 40% for SC/ST, provided the candidate has studied Mathematics as one of the optional subjects in the Two Year PU or equivalent.

3. MSc (Mathematics)

BSc with Mathematics as Major / Optional subject with minimum aggregate marks (excluding languages) of 45% for GM and 40% for SC/ST **or** BScEd degree of Regional Institute of Education with Mathematics as a special subject.

4. MSc (Biotechnology)

A degree in BSc with Biotechnology as one of the optional subjects of any recognized University **or** a degree in BSc (Natural Science Combination) of any recognized University. Minimum aggregate marks of 55% in optionals for GM and 50% for SC/ST.

5. MSc (Biochemistry)

A degree in BSc with Biochemistry / Chemistry as one of the optional subjects of any recognized University. Minimum aggregate of 45% marks in Biochemistry for GM and 40% for SC/ST & Category-I **or** average minimum aggregate of 45% marks in optional Subjects where Chemistry is one of the optional subjects for GM and 40% for SC/ST & Category-I.

6. MSc (Computer Science)

A degree in BSc with Computer Science / Computer Maintenance / Electronics / Instrumentation as one of the optional subjects of any recognised University or a degree in BSc (IT) (from recognised regular University or recognised Open University) even without Mathematics in their two year PU, Diploma (in Electronics, Computer Science and Information Technology) holders with BSc (IT) are permitted, if they have SSLC level Mathematics / BCA degree from regular or Open University or a degree in BSc with Mathematics and one-two among Computer Science / Computer Maintenance / Electronics / Instrumentation / Physics subjects in their degree. Minimum aggregate marks of 45% for GM and 40% for SC/ST

7. MSc (Botany)

B.Sc with Botany as Major / Optional subject with minimum aggregate marks (excluding languages) of 45% for GM and 40% for SC/ST or B.ScEd degree of Regional Institute of Education with Botany as a special subject.

8. MSc (Zoology)

B.Sc with Zoology as Major / Optional subject with minimum aggregate marks (excluding languages) of 45% for GM and 40% for SC/ST or B.ScEd degree of Regional Institute of Education with Zoology as a special subject.

9. Master of Commerce (M.Com.)

A degree in BCom / BBM/BBA of any recognized University with minimum aggregate marks (excluding languages) of 45% for GM and 40% for SC/ST

10. Master of Social Work (MSW)

A degree in BA/BSc / BCom / BBM / LLB of any recognized University with minimum marks (excluding languages) of 45% for GM and 40% for SC/ST.

11. MA (Kannada)

BA/BSc/BA Performing Arts, with Kannada as Major / Optional subject with minimum aggregate marks (excluding languages) of 45% for GM and 40% SC/ST.

- or Degree with Post-PrepUniversity Diploma in Kannada
- or Pandit Examination of Karnataka Government
- or B.Ed. Degree with S.S.L.C. and Vidwat Examination of the University of Madras.

12. MA (English)

BA with English as a Major or Optional subject with minimum aggregate marks (excluding languages) of 50% for GM and 45% for SC/ST and Category I candidates.

- or BAEd degree of Regional Institute of Education
- or Degree with Postgraduate Diploma in English of University of Mysore / Open University

13. M.Voc. (Software development)

B.Sc. with Computer Science / Computer Applications / Computer Maintenance / Electronics as an optional. OR BCA Candidates should have studied Mathematics as a major or minor subject in their BCA / B.Sc. degree. OR A Degree in B.Sc (IT) even without Mathematics in their Two-Year PU or Diploma (in Electronics, Computer Science and information Technology) are permitted, if they have SSLC level Mathematics. Or B.E. (IT), B.E (IS) OR B. Tech (Sofware Engineering) OR B.E. (Computer Science) form recognized University.

14. M. Voc (Food Processing and Engineering)

B.Sc. with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as major / Optional subjects OR B. Pharm / B.Sc. with Food Science & Nutrition / Home Science / Catering & Hotel Management / Biotechnology / Chemistry / Biochemistry / Microbiology / other Life Sciences provided the candidate has studied Mathematics as one of the optional subjects in the Two Year P.U.C. or equivalent. OR B.Sc. (Ag) OR B. Tech / B.E. (Food Nutrition and Dietetics / Food Process Engineering / Agriculture Engineering / Chemical Engineering / Biotechnology / Bioinformatics) from recognized University.

50% seats of the total intake for all the Master Programmes of the college will be filled-up by University of Mysore through Centralized Admission Cell as per University regulations.

Remaining 50% seats will be filled-up by the College under College Quota.


Submission of Applications


