EDITORIAL:

Academic Report 2022-23 is an effort to showcase of the college activities of the year. The report highlights the contributions and achievements of the college as a unit, the achievements of teachers and students in curricular, co-curricular and extra curricular field towards attaining scholastic excellence.

This documentation is to motivate the teaching, non-teaching staff members and students towards increased contributions of in the above said fields. To achieve the same, the compilation of academic and administrative activities for the year has been done.

To list the achievements of the college during the year, our 20 teachers from 09 departments have been guiding 68 research scholars for their doctoral degree. Further, towards successful achievements of the college objectives, 36 internal committees along with 05 statutory committees were framed and also conducted 09 annual regular activities, 13 Workshops, 01 Conference, 9 Seminar/Webinars, 02 Training Programmes, 11 Special Lectures, 09 Orientation Programmes, Observation of 05 Special Days, 02 Extension Activities, 01 Awareness Programmes, 05 educational tours and 02 Induction Programmes (for students of UG and PG) along with regular annual activities, sports, NCC and NSS events. Our teachers are working on 02 major research projects. Put together, 40 teachers have published 70 research papers among which 25 papers published in Scopus Indexed journals, 15 in Web of Science Indexed journals, 17 are in UGC CARE Listed journals and 13 in other peer reviewed journals. 05 teachers have been published 12 papers as book chapters. Another 15 teachers have presented 28 research papers among which 02 in State level platforms, 11 in National level and 15 at International platforms. During the year, 03 books have been authored/edited by our teachers and 06 are serving in Editorial Boards of 17 Journals at various levels. They have actively participated in 75 knowledge sharing platoforms oganised by external institutes along with the events organised by the college. Apart from these, 02 of our young teachers were awarded with Ph D degree. It can also be witnessed our teachers attending Orientation / Refresher /Faculty Development courses, completing Swaym/MOOCs and serving as resource person in various platforms as well as members in various internal committees. It is also an acknowledgment that 05 research scholars have presented their research papers in various national level platforms, 02 students worked on external funded projects, presented 05 research papers in national level conferences and paritipated in 05 knowledge sharing platoforms of other institutes during the year. They have made significant remarks in NCC, NSS, Sports and Cultural activiteies through out the year. In sum, it is an affirmative indicator to acknowledge increased performernce of the College.

All these achievements were possible only because of the divine blessings of His Holiness Jagadguru Sri. ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Started in 1964, JSS College of Arts, Commerce and Science (JSSCACS), Ooty Road, Mysuru is a Multi-faculty, Co-educational and Autonomous College. JSSCACS is one among more than 350 varied institutions run by JSS Mahavidyapeetha. The autonomous status was accorded in 2005. It is re-accredited by NAAC with "A" Grade (IV Cycle, CGPA: 3.21). UGC has recognized the College as 'College with Potential for Excellence'. The College has Biotechnology Skill Enhancement Progamme (BiSEP) sanctioned by the Government of Karnataka. DDU Kaushala Kendra and Kaushalya Karnataka scheme have been sanctioned to the college by UGC and GoK, respectively. The College has Community Radio Station named as JSS Radio FM 91.2 sanctioned by Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, GoI. The College has been recognized as 'Research Centre' by University of Mysore to undertake doctoral research in 9 subjects. The College is known to provide need based, skill integrated, cost-effective, quality and holistic education, transforming the students into globally competitive, employable and responsible citizens. The College has implemented NEP-2020 for UG programmes from 2021-22. The College has been rated as 'Gold College' by QS-iGUAGE and ranked at 72nd and 13th place in India and Karnataka, respectively, by Education World Survey.

The College has Women's Hostel with the capacity to accommodate 277 students. At present the college is offering 26 Academic Programmes including 21 UG, 15 PG and 09 Ph D Programmes. Various other postgraduate diploma, advanced diploma programmes also offered.

The College has highly qualified and dedicated 166 teachers among which 54 are Ph D awarded & 60 non-teaching staff. Nearly 3583 students with wide diversity in all levels are purusing education in various disciplines. It has an excellent academic record as students secure ranks and honours; many Alumni are successful Literateurs, Politicians, Administrators and Enterpreneurs. The College also has a conducive atmosphere for sports and cultural activities. It has sophisticated indoor and outdoor sports facilities. Students have brought laurels to the college in Sports, Debate, Drama and Music at Inter-collegieate, University, State and National level competitions. The volunteers of NCC & NSS units have participated in State and National level Camps and Republic Day Parades. Besides, Youth Red Cross Unit and a number of student centric clubs are also functioning. 
