INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON MATHEMATICS IN JSS COLLEGE, MYSORE

Mysore. Dec.26: A Two day International Conference on 'Mathematics -Yesterday and Today' sponsored by UGC, New Delhi was inaugurated by Dr. Muli Mani, Vice-Chancellor, BLDE University, Bijapur.
