

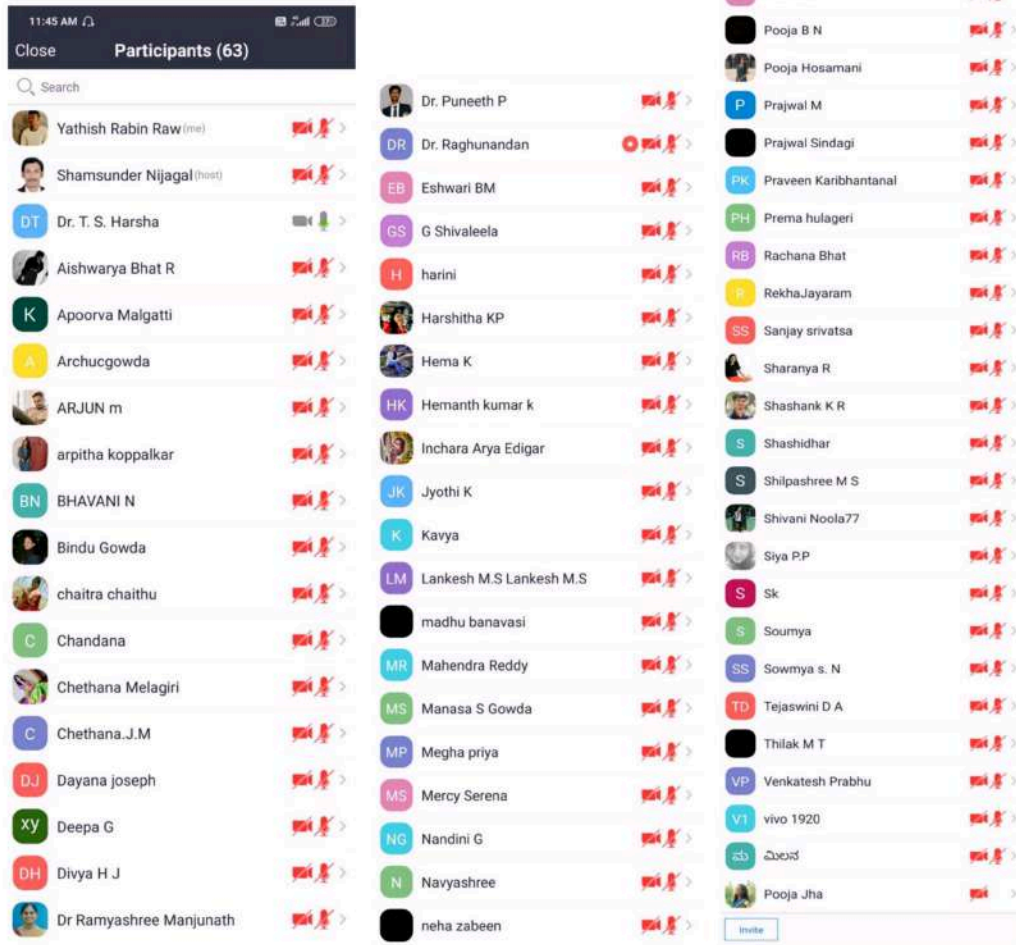

A webinar on "Bio-ecology of Zooplanktons" aimed to enhance participants' understanding of aquatic ecology, focusing on Zooplanktons

- Nanoplanktonic Flagellates**: Characterized by either a long tail used for swimming (flagellates) OR by hair-like structures called cilia (Ciliates)
- Cnidaria**: contains the colonial siphonophores and the scyphozoans—also known as the true jellyfish
- Rotifers**:
  - Most are non-motile, about 100 species are holoplanktonic.
  - Rotifers eat bacteria, detritus, other rotifers, algae or protozoa.
  - Rotifers are highly efficient reproducers

Over 60 participants, including PG and UG faculties and students from various institutions, attended the webinar using Zoom. The event, organized by Dr. M. Ramyashree and Dr. B.S.
