


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A One-day workshop titled "Science behind superstition" by Prof. Narendra Nayak







The PG Department of Zoology organized a one-day workshop on the "Science behind Superstition" on September 8, 2022. Prof. Narendra Nayak, President of the Federation of Indian Rationalists Association (FIRA) and former professor of Biochemistry, Kasturba Medical College, Mangalore, served as the resource person for the program. The event, presided over by Prof. B V Sambashivaiah, Chief Executive of JSSCACS, Prof. Vijayendra Kumar, Principal of JSSCACS, Prof. Panditharadhya, Retired Professor of Kannada, UOM, and Dr. Ramyashree M, HOD of the PG Department of Zoology, witnessed the active participation of 100 attendees.

Prof. Sambashivaiah, in his presidential remarks, addressed prevalent superstitions in society, emphasizing their hindrance to scientific and rational thinking. Ms. Akhila M P, Assistant Professor in the PG Department of Zoology, introduced Prof. Narendra Nayak, who commenced the workshop by discussing prejudice and delving into issues related to non-science, bad science, pseudo-science, and anti-science in contemporary society.

Prof. Nayak elucidated the science behind purported supernatural acts, showcasing examples such as materializing objects from thin air and walking on hot coals. He exposed pseudoscientific practices, including mid-brain activation camps and natural "therapies" lacking scientific backing. The session also addressed anti-scientific rumors, such as claims of increased magnetism in the body and electric conductivity post-vaccination.



The technical talk was organized with an objective to explore about Data mining tools Weka and its usage in classification, Clustering, Visualization and Association of data.

Data mining is the process of sorting through large data sets to identify patterns and relationships that can help solve business problems through data analysis. Data mining techniques and tools enable enterprises to predict future trends and make more-informed business decisions.

Types of Data Mining: Each of the following data mining techniques serves several different business problems and provides a different insight into each of them. However, understanding the type of business problem you need to solve will also help in knowing which technique will be best to use, which will yield the best results. The Data Mining types can be divided into two basic parts that are as follows:

As the name signifies, Predictive Data-Mining analysis works on the data that may help to know what may happen later (or in the future) in business. Predictive Data-Mining can also be further divided into four types that are listed below:

- Classification Analysis
- Regression Analysis
- Time Serious Analysis
- Prediction Analysis

The main goal of the Descriptive Data Mining tasks is to summarize or turn given data into relevant information. The Descriptive Data-Mining Tasks can also be further divided into four types that are as follows:

- Clustering Analysis
- Summarization Analysis
- Association Rules Analysis
- Sequence Discovery Analysis

Weka Data mining tool is a collection of machine learning algorithms for data mining tasks. It contains tools for data preparation, classification, regression, clustering, association rules mining, and visualization.
