Report on Internship Programme on Project Management

Speaker: Dr. R Datta Kumar Head- operations EnhanzED Education Ltd. Mysuru

A Project Management lecture was delivered as part of the Internship Special Lecture series by the resource person Dr. R Datta Kumar on 19th April 2024, in the Golden Jubilee Hall of the College.

Dr. R Datta Kumar emphasised during the session that Project management methods can be applied to any project. It is often tailored to a specific type of project based on project size, nature, industry or sector. For example, the construction industry, which focuses on the delivery of things like buildings, roads, and bridges, has developed its own specialized form of project management that it refers to as *construction project management* and in which project managers can become trained and certified.

According to Dr. R Datta Kumar the success of any project depends on how well four key aspects are aligned with the contextual dynamics affecting the project, these are referred to as the four P's.

- Plan: The planning and forecasting activities.
- Process: The overall approach to all activities and project governance.
- People: Including dynamics of how they collaborate and communicate.
- Power: Lines of authority, decision-makers, policies for implementation and the like.

The resource person focused on the stages of a project life cycle, sometimes referred to as process groups. In order to manage the task through a series of discrete steps that need to be accomplished, he underlined that each process group comprises a number of interrelated processes.

The resource person provided the students with insightful advice on how to identify the variables that affect project success.

The Chief Executive of the college, Professor B V Sambashivaiah, presided over the program and the Principal Dr. Prathibha S was the guest of honour.

The session benefited around 500 students VI Semester of Under Graduation in the Arts, Commerce, and Science streams.
