Prof. B. V. Sambashivaiah sought the clarity for the support for Internship placement for 6th Semester Undergraduate students. Dr. Shankar Prasad agreed to extend his organization support for internship placement for B.Sc., Computer Science, BCA and B.Voc – Software Development students. Dr. Ramaprasad, Principal Scientist, CFTRI informed the gathering, that the CFTRI provides internship training to students on chargeable basis and also mentioned that, as JSS College is having MoU with CFTRI, it would be easy to place the students for internship. Further, he also added that he will bring the issue to the notice of the Director of CFTRI.

Prof. K. N. Mohana expressed his apprehension about the less number of research article publications in journals. And he suggested to have Internal fellowship for Ph.D., scholars of about Rs. 10000/- to Rs. 15000/- per month, so that number of Ph.D., scholars will also increase and thereby increase in the number of research article publications.

The DCED also recommended to increase the number of research article publications and presentations in Conferences/Seminars/Workshops by teachers.
