



Formation of Students Forums – 2022-23 Rules & Regulations

- 1. The selection for the class representatives will be held on 24.12.2022 Saturday at 11.30 AM
- 2. At the time of selection, students should be in their allotted rooms only.
- 3. First bell for the entry of degree students is at 11:10 AM, final bell at 11:20 AM. Entry is not allowed after the second bell.
- 4. After the second bell, the selection officers will explain the rules and regulations to the voters and the names of the contestants will be written on the Black Board with the serial numbers in alphabetical order.
- 5. While selecting the class representatives voters should write only the candidates serial number in the Ballot paper.
- 6. The Ballot papers if over written, if written in words or struck, they will be invalid.
- 7. Before voting, please clear your doubts from the officers.
- 8. The Ballot paper model will be shown to you at the right time.
- 9. During campaigning nothing should be stick or written on the college walls or compounds or in any public construction. And if such cases come to the notice of the committee, such candidate will be disqualified.
- 10. Counting: In case two candidates get equal number of votes, the result will be decided through the lottery system in the presence of the Principal.
- 11. The counting of votes can be witnessed by the candidate or his agent. (One for each room).
- 12. All the students should bring their I D Card during voting and should produce it when asked by the officers. In case of no I D Card you can bring your receipt also otherwise they will not be allowed to vote.
- 13. In case of change in combination or section the student should possess Fee paid receipt along with ID card. Otherwise they wil not be allowed to vote.
- 14. On any matters relating to counting the decision of Committee and Principal is final.

- 15. On the day of selection outsiders are not allowed to enter the college campus. If any one violates the rules, he will be strictly punished.
- 16. Only boys should vote for the class representatives. Girls' representatives will be chosen by girls separately.
