**REPORT OF
DHEEKSHARAMBH UG STUDENTS INDUCTION PROGRAMME 2024-25**

Date: 09 & 10 August 2024

As an IQAC initiative two day DHEEKSHARAMBH-UG Students Induction Programme was organized by the college on 9 and 10 August 2024. The programme was inaugurated by the Director of College Development Council of University of Mysore, Prof. D. Anand. In his inaugural address Prof. D Anand told the young UG first year students that **"The dreams of the nation can only be achieved through the youths"**.

Prof. D Anand welcomed students and praised their decision to join the esteemed institution while inaugurating Deeksharambh, UG students' induction programme, at JSS College of Arts Commerce and science, Ooty road, Mysuru. He underscored the pivotal role of education in shaping lives and highlighted the privilege of accessing higher education, which many students around the world are deprived of. Prof. Anand described the students as being at a critical juncture in their lives, emphasizing the transition they are undergoing. He urged them to introspect about their goals and aspirations, asserting that those who capitalize on this formative period will achieve notable success in the future. Referencing Dr: APJ Abdul Kalam's vision of India becoming a superpower by 2020, Prof. DANand acknowledged the challenges that have hindered this dream but reassured students that their contributions remain vital for nation-building. The keynote speaker emphasized the importance of developing one's personality through education, fostering curiosity, and pursuing multi-disciplinary knowledge.

In the presidential speech, Chief Executive of the College, Professor B.V. Sambashivaiah, offered guidance to the students. He stressed the importance of adapting to the new academic environment and institution. He reflected on the contributions of JSS Mahavidyapeetha to education and highlighted the college's commitment to holistic student development. He spoke about the importance of the induction programme in introducing students to their responsibilities and the college environment. He outlined the four core principles of "Deeksharambh": Socializing, Associating, Governing and Experiencing, urging students to embrace these values. Prof. B V Sambashivaiah assured the students of the college's unwavering support in helping them achieve their dreams and become responsible citizens.
