**26.1. Welcome**

Member Secretary, Prof. M. Mahadevappa sought blessings of the Chairperson, His Holiness Jagadguru Sri Shivarathri Deshikendra Mahaswamiji, extended cordial welcome to the Hon'ble Members and Special Invitees of the Governing Body.

Member secretary requested Dr. C G Betsurmth, Executive Secretary, to preside over the meeting.

Member Secretary took up the agenda for discussion and resolutions.

Member Secretary presented the details of suggestions from the previous meeting and the action taken against the suggestions.

**28.4 Research Centre: Fresh Recognition**

Member Secretary presented the information on the efforts put in for the fresh recognition of research centre of various departments of the college. The Chairperson, Dr. C G Betsurmath enquired about the current status of the process for which Prof. B V Sambashivaiah gave a detailed information about the hurdles in continuation of research centre activities through Foundation and the ongoing process of new recognition. He also mentioned that already enrolled scholars from the various subjects can continue their studies through JSS Research Foundation without disturbances, but the future enrolment will be after fresh recognition from UOM.

**28.5. Discontinuation of the courses: Certificate and Diploma in Animation (Non UGC)**

The Chairperson, Dr C G Betsurmath sought detailed information about the present courses for which Prof. B V Sambashivaiah furnished the details. The causes and consequences of closure of courses were discussed. Dr C G Betsurmath recalled his experience during the exposure trip to Bharatiyaar University to witness the best practices, among which Community College Scheme was also one and consented to

retain UGC Community College Scheme and to close the Certificate and Diploma courses in Animation. Prof. R Rangappa seconded the decision.

## **28.6. Smart Campus**

Member Secretary presented the information about preparation of the college about converting the college into smart campus. The Chairperson, Dr. C G Betsurmath asked Prof. B V Samabshivaiah, Chief Executive of the college to make Smart Campus presentation for the consideration of other invitees. After the Power Point Presentation, he advised to work on the proposed financial budget on each key element, for which Prof. R Rangappa supported.

## **28.7. Progress Report**

### **A. Activities of the College**

Member Secretary presented the information. The Chairperson, Dr C G Betsurmath enquired Prof. P Venkataramaiah who served as Resource Person in one of the Orientation Programmes conducted by the college during the period. Prof. P Venkataramaiah mentioned about less scope for discussion after the presentation. Dr C G Betsurmath advised to create more scope for interaction after presentation on such platforms in future. He further mentioned to publish the abstracts of the papers presented by the resource persons in seminar/conference in the respective souvenirs, which can strengthen the documentation of the college.

Dr C G Betsurmath further sought the information whether the organized NSS camps and framed activities within are need based, for which Member Secretary Prof. M Mahadevappa acknowledged the identified needs. He further asked about the quality of community participation in camp activities. Member Secretary explained that,

community participation took place in the evening activities. The chairperson directed to insert the pictures depicting community participation for strengthening documentation.

### **B. Activities of the Students:**

Chairperson Dr C G Betsurmath enquired about the decreased results in I & III semester examinations, specially with BA when compared to other semesters. The Member Secretary mentioned that, since majority of the students are from rural background they find English as a difficult subject. Dr. C G Betsurmath suggested for at least presentations from English and any other department in the next GB meeting about departmental activities, initiatives taken by the department towards improvement of teachers as well as students' performance which can facilitate review process and provide a motivating message to the other department heads.

Prof. P Venkataramaiah extended a suggestion to create 'Talent Development Centre', in which students' hub has to be developed. As members around 100 talented students have to be chosen who will participate in Group discussions on various subjects periodically under the supervision of the respective teachers-in-charge. After certain time, the students from other colleges can also be invited to participate in the discussion. Prof. R Rangappa and Dr. C G Betsurmath welcomed the idea.

### **C. Academic Activities of the Teacher**

Regarding the teachers pursuing Ph D in the college, the Chairperson Dr C G Betsurmath suggested to include details about guide, topic and registration date.

The Chairperson Dr C G Betsurmath sought detailed information about the projects undertaken by the faculty members. He also sought reason for reduced number of projects in the college for which Prof. B V Sambashivaiah mentioned that funding agencies are not active for the period. Dr C G Betsurmath suggested to continue efforts in the direction.

Prof. Venkataramaiah sought details about Mr. N.M. Prathap, III B Sc (CBZ) student for his extra ordinary achievements and suggested to motivate such talents. The Chairperson Dr. C G Betsurmth mentioned the significance of giving publicity to such candidates which can improve the admission of the college with more quality students for which Prof. B V Sambashivaiah mentioned that such achievements are published in news papers. The chairperson also suggested to honour Mr. N.M. Prathap, III B Sc (CBZ) student, in the upcoming functions so that the publicity take up widely.

Regarding publications by the faculty, it was suggested to classify them as in books and journals.

#### **E. Library Information**

University Nominee Mr. MSS Kumar enquired about digitalization of library for which Prof. B V Sambashivaiah acknowledged partial digitalization and also mentioned about huge investment for complete digitalization. Dr C G Betsurmth suggested keeping the proposal ready for timely support.

The Chairperson Dr C G Betsurmth enquired about the working hours of the library, and suggested to extend the timings till 8 pm. Prof. B V Sambashivaiah explained about the efforts put in the past on the same line, which was not utilized by the students properly. Further Dr. C G Betsurmth suggested to conduct training classes to the students towards preparing them to appear for competitive exams.
